EU water policy in practice: Invitation for a one day study-trip to AGBAR's water management sites on 1st March 2013 in Barcelona, Spain

Dear Madam,

On behalf of SUEZ ENVIRONNEMENT and its affiliate AGBAR, we would like to invite you to participate in a **one-day study trip to Barcelona**, **Spain** designed to provide you with a hands-on, practical insight into state-of-the-art solutions for water resources management **as part of the current debate on the protection of water resources in Europe**.

The EU Commission has recently released a **Blueprint to safeguard water** resources in Europe and launched a **European Innovation Partnership** to solve upcoming innovation challenges related to water issues. The implementation of these two initiatives will take place over the long-term and will depend upon the smooth integration of EU water policy objectives within other EU policy areas (agriculture, industry, energy...). It will depend also and directly on the actions undertaken by stakeholders since many of the measures foreseen will be implemented on voluntary basis. This is why we believe that this study trip will provide food for thought to policy makers across the three institutions and to stakeholders involved in the debate.

The proposed trip will take you to several installations of **AGBAR** in Barcelona. It will, among others, illustrate the stakes and challenges of the EU water policy, in the context of a major city in Europe, and the solutions provided to address these challenges.

You will find attached the draft programme of the trip, which will take place on **Friday 1**st **March 2013**, with a departure from Brussels on the eve by a direct flight from Brussels to Barcelona. The return trip is foreseen on Friday evening.

The programme will include:

- A visit of the operational control center managing water for the city of Barcelona;
- A visit of a drinking water treatment plant (showcasing different types of treatment);
- A debate on the stakes and challenges of EU Water policy.

Upon request as per your registration form, SUEZ ENVIRONNEMENT will provide assistance and cover the costs of airline travels to/from Brussels and accommodation at Silken Hotel in Barcelona.

Participants will include MEPs and policy advisors, Commission officials, Member States representatives and NGOs. The visits will be conducted in English. Please note that the number of participants will be limited to 15 persons.
